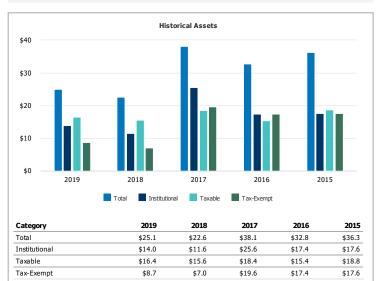

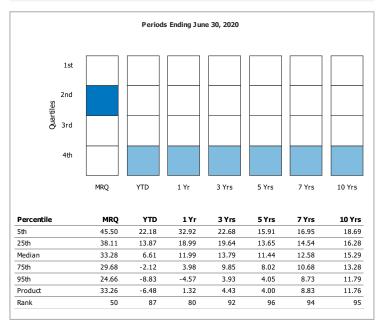

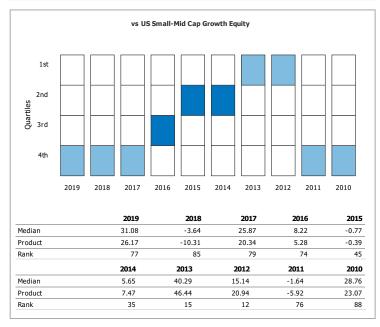

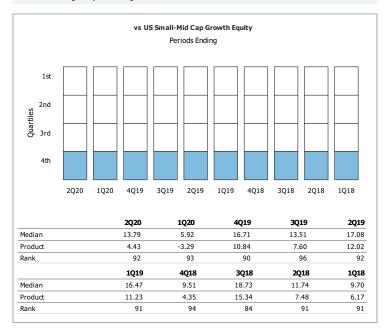
Universe Ranking Analysis: Annualized Returns

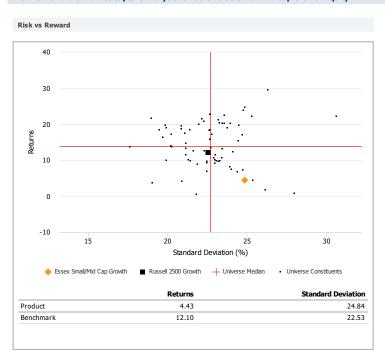
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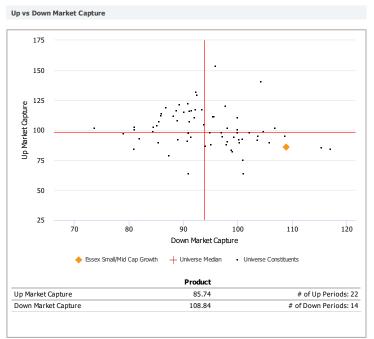

Risk vs Reward & Market Capture Analysis: 3 Years vs US Small-Mid Cap Growth Equity

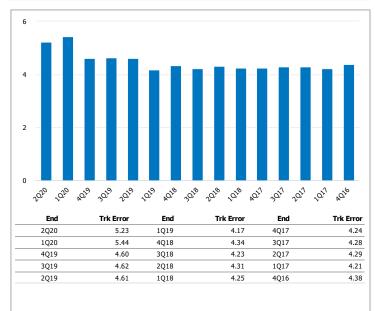




Market Capture Analysis: 3 Years
